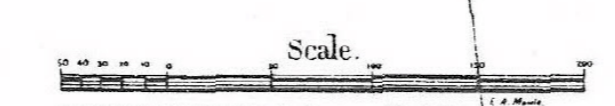


RAILWAY MAP OF AUSTRALIA
