The Australian Government is funding opportunities for up to 300,000 apprenticeships and traineeships, to ensure workers have the right skills for the workforce.

Australian Apprenticeships can offer eligible employers financial incentives up to \$10,500 (GST inclusive) to help you when you take on an apprentice, particularly if the apprenticeship is in a trade experiencing a skill shortage.
