## Youth Jobs PaTH – National overview - 22 October 2017

### PaTH Prepare – Employability Skills Training

- **2,120** Courses been approved in the Department's Systems:
  - **1,428** Courses have been completed
  - o **109** are in progress
  - o 583 are scheduled
- 12,522 commencements in Employability Skills Training Courses
  - o For 10,151 individual job seekers

## PaTH Trial – Internships

- **2,545** internship placements have commenced to date with 1,450 businesses.
  - **711** young people are currently undertaking an internship in a business.
  - o **1,115** internship placements have successfully completed, of which:
    - **723** resulted in employment with the host business and 35 resulted in employment with another business (68% of placements that have successfully completed)
    - 308 (28%) did not result in employment
    - **49** (4%) ended early with no offer of employment with agreement by the host, intern and provider
  - **617** ended early without employment
  - **102** are pending an end reason.
  - 19.% of PaTH internships have been agreed for 30-39 hours of participation per fortnight, 20.7% for 40-49 hours per fortnight and 59.5% for the maximum 50 hours per fortnight.

## PaTH Hire - Youth Bonus Wage Subsidy

- **12,055** Agreements (**1,513** terminated).
  - o 6,019 Claimed 12 Week Outcomes.
  - o 2,133 Claimed 26 Week Outcomes

# Youth Jobs PaTH- South Australia – 15 October 2017

### PaTH Prepare – Employability Skills Training

There are currently 14 providers contracted to deliver Employability Skills training in SA. Another provider was contracted but has left the market since 1 April 2017.

- 177 Courses been approved in the Department's Systems:
  - o **111** Courses have been completed
  - **9** are in progress
  - **57** are scheduled
- 982 commencements in Employability Skills Training Courses
  - For **880** unique job seekers
- **21.0%** of young people participating in EST have progressed into an Internship and/or Job Placement
  - This is only slightly below the national average of **23.9%**
  - 162 progressed straight into a job placement
  - o 10 progressed into a PaTH Internship and then a job placement
  - o 13 have commenced into a PaTH Internship

### <u> Trial – PaTH internships</u>

- **175** PaTH internships placements commenced to date in South Australia:
  - **66** young people were still undertaking an internship
  - o 109 ended, of which 43 (39%) gained employment
    - **68** (62%) placements successfully completed, of which:
      - **63** per cent (43) gained employment with either the host business or another business
      - 35 per cent (24) did not result in employment
      - one per cent (1) ended early with no offer of employment as agreed by the host, intern and their provider
    - 30 (28%) ended early without employment
    - 11 (10%) were pending an end reason.

### Hire - PaTH Youth Bonus Wage Subsidies

- **1,368** Youth Jobs Bonus Wage Subsidy agreements for South Australia.
- **77.8** per cent of wage subsidy placements that are eligible for a 12 week outcome have achieved it. This compares to **80%** nationally.
