I am writing to provide a correction to a response the Australian National Audit Office (ANAO) provided to a written Question on Notice (QoN) in relation to the Senate Finance and Public Administration Committee's 2019-20 Supplementary Budget Estimates inquiry in March 2020.

In response to QoN 327 on Legal Costs, for the 2019-20 YTD period (1 July 2019 to 18 March 2020) the ANAO provided the figure of \$146,591.84 for 'external legal costs' and 'total legal costs' of \$405,817.84.

In preparing the ANAO's Legal Services Expenditure Report 2019-20, which the ANAO is required to make publically available in accordance with the Legal Services Directions 2017 and is available at https://www.anao.gov.au/about/accountability-and-reporting, it was discovered that the amount of \$11,038.26 had been incorrectly attributed as an external legal cost.

For the period 1 July to 18 March 2020, the correct figure for the ANAO's external legal costs is \$135,553.58 and total legal costs is \$394,779.58.
