Clarifications to Hansard

On page 106 of the transcripts, in response to a question asked by Senator Waters, Mr Pringle stated:

Mr Pringle: Thank you. Can I just clarify one last thing before we conclude. I do have the answer to one of the senator's questions earlier in terms of the number of Family Court judges that are in the process of retiring. To the end of this year, to the end of 2021, we understand that there'll be nine.

The Courts wish to clarify that there will be 7 judicial retirements in the Family Court of Australia by the end of 2021, and a further 2 known retirements by the end of 2022.
