

AFP Timeline – receipt of allegation relating to the Hon Christian Porter MP

24 February 2021 Approximately 3pm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • AFP Superintendent at APH contacted by the office of Ms HAMMOND MP. • AFP immediately attended Ms HAMMOND's office. Dossier was provided to AFP.
24 February 2021 Afternoon / evening	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Internal AFP emails summarising allegations, steps taken by AFP, confirmation of reporting lines and briefing to superiors, discussion about referring matter to AFP Sensitive Investigations Oversight Board (SIOB).
25 February 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Case Note Entry completed by AFP. Referred to AFP in Sydney for contact with NSW Police; and to AFP in Adelaide to seek information regarding the Coronial Enquiry.
25 February 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Email from AFP to contacts in NSW Police with a copy of the Case Note Entry, containing a comprehensive summary of the dossier.
26 February 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Call from Senator Hanson-Young to AFP advising of receipt of the documents alleging rape by the Hon. Christian Porter MP.

28 February 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Phone call by AFP to SA Coroner's Office. Advised Criminal Investigations Branch had completed their investigation, however the post –mortem referral takes 12 months from the time of death.
28 February 2021 Afternoon	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Phone contact between AFP and NSW Police – AFP was advised the NSW Police case was closed after advice received from complainant on 23 June 2020 not to progress.
28 February 2021 Evening	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact made by AFP Deputy Commissioner Operations and Assistant Commissioner Eastern Command to NSW Police counterparts – seeking information about the NSW Police matter.
