The Government has allocated \$10.8 million over three years commencing 1 July 2017, for the Digital Records Transformation Program. This has not changed.

To date, \$1.6 million has been spent.

Question 2

Senator Patrick has asked:

Can the Department of Finance provide the following information on the delivery of the Streamlining Government Grants Administration Program?

- 1. The budget for the project at the time of first approval to proceed?
- 2. The spend to date on the project?
- 3. The current approved budget?

Response

In the 2015-16 Budget, the Government allocated \$106.7 million over four years to the Streamlining Government Grants Administration (SGGA) Program. Of this allocation:

- \$99.3 million was provided to the Department of Social Services (DSS); questions related to this allocation should be referred to DSS; and
- \$7.4 million was provided to the Department of Finance (Finance); expenditure to date is \$3.5 million.

An additional \$35.2 million over two years was allocated in the 2017-18 Budget under the Modernisation Fund to the support agencies to transition grants programs to the Hubs and build the capability of the Hubs, bringing the total budget for SGGA to \$141.9 million. Of the Modernisation Fund allocation:

- \$23.2 million was provided to DSS and \$12.0 million was provided to Department of Industry, Innovation and Science (DIIS); advice to Finance on expenditure to date is \$5.1 million, consistent with transition schedules.
- Further advice regarding this expenditure should be referred to DSS and DIIS.
