Transcript:

CHAIR: Thank you very much for that. You can go first, if you're ready to go, Senator Bragg.

Senator BRAGG: Yes. G'day; how are you?

Mr Pawluk: Good thanks, Senator. How are you?

Senator BRAGG: Good thanks. You're independent, are you, from the super system?

Mr Pawluk: Yes. We are not part of the super system.

Senator BRAGG: Okay. Do you receive any money from the super funds?

Mr Pawluk: Yes, we have super funds that are members.

Senator BRAGG: Are they financial members?

Mr Pawluk: Yes, they are.

Senator BRAGG: How much do they pay?

Mr Pawluk: I don't have that information in front of me.

Senator BRAGG: Do you have a rough idea?

Mr Pawluk: It's a relatively small part of our membership. We have got a range of diverse sectors and types of organisations, and they're a pretty small part of it overall.

Senator BRAGG: Can you provide that on notice, how much money you receive from superannuation funds?

Mr Pawluk: Yes, I can answer that question on notice.
