I am writing to correct evidence given during the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade appearance at the inquiry into the rights of women and children hearing on Wednesday 8 March 2023.

I would like to correct my responses as identified below:

- To the Chair, Ms Maria Vamvakinou MP's question that relates to conflicts (refer to proof Hansard page 1) specifically, 'At the time of the Conference they identified that there were 18 regions in the world where there were conflicts and where violence against women and children were occurring'.
 - I mistakenly referenced *'regions'* when I meant to say *'active conflicts'*, as per the <u>UK</u> <u>Foreign Secretary's opening remarks.</u>
- To Senator Reynolds' request that relates to the release of the second National Action Plan (refer to proof Hansard Page 3).
 - I advised that it was the *'middle of this year'* however I should have advised *'at the end of the year'*.
 - Further, I incorrectly drew reference to *'recommendations'*, however there will be no recommendations.
