Dear Committee

I wish to make a submission to the COVID-19 Discrimination Inquiry

By way of introduction, I am a dermatologist in Tasmania, and my family and I have been affected and traumatised by the mandates

I strongly believe that Government should **never** have the power to inject their citizens with a substance under threat/coercion of job loss.

As far as I understand the Constitution of Australia, we have certain rights and freedoms and these were not followed during COVID mandates.

To pit the right/freedom to work against the right/freedom of bodily integrity is immoral and unethical and discriminatory. The Government took no notice of freedom of choice, freedom of bodily integrity, freedom of conscience or freedom of religion (for those who had religious injection)

The Australian Vaccine Handbook states that to have a vaccine/jab one must give informed consent. The threat of job loss immediately immediately cancels the ability to give informed consent.

The last time experimental procedures were carried out on populations, the perpetrators ended up at Nuremberg.

In relation to the COVID jabs (I prefer not to call them vaccines given they are not vaccines in the traditional sense of the word vaccine), the jabs are experimental, did not stop people contracting the disease and did not stop disease spread. Evidence is emerging that people who are COVID-jabbed do worse than their un-jabbed peers, for example, virtually all COVID patients in NSW ICUs are jabbed. To inject people with unproven and unsafe substances is simply malevolent.

We know hundreds of people who took the jab to save their jobs and who would otherwise not have taken the jab. This is discrimination. We also know several people who have had significant jab injuries including heart attacks, serious clots, strokes and neurological problems. This is heartbreaking

As a family, my wife had to close her medical practice and my two sons could not attend University because they exercised their freedom to choose not to be vaccinated.

Fortunately or unfortunately, I was so ill when the mandates were introduced that I was given an exemption, although one doctor I saw tried to pressure me into being vaccinated despite my illness and my inability to give informed consent.

The 1997 Public Health Act gives the Director of Public Health, during an emergency, to do whatever he sees fit, and this unelected official used this draconian law to stamp his authority on the public (without listening to any objections)

So I implore the committee, please make sure that these draconian laws are

changed so that **never** again can Government force its citizens to be injected with a substance under threat of job loss, or any other threat.
