Environmental regulation: Industry perspectives

The House Environment Committee will continue gathering evidence at a public hearing in Canberra this Friday, as part of its inquiry into streamlining environmental regulation, 'green tape', and one stop shops for environmental assessments and approvals.

Representatives from key bodies in the fields of primary industries, manufacturing, development and infrastructure will appear before the Committee. The Committee Chair, Mr Alex Hawke MP, said "We want to hear about specific examples where the current regulations have hindered development with no benefit to the environment. It is time to cut through duplication, end inefficiency and simplify the environmental assessment and approval processes for the benefit of all Australians."
