Response:

Less than a third of KPMG partners have structured their affairs in accordance with the High Court's decision and ATO guidance on Everett Assignments. KPMG does not have a policy of promoting or prohibiting Everett Assignments. The role of Everett Assignments has changed over time, consistent with the guidance of the ATO. We expect that the number of Everett Assignments in place will diminish over time as partners retire and, given the changed ATO guidance, less partners enter into these arrangements.
