

Commonwealth Electoral Amendment (Donation Reform and Other Measures) Bill 2020

But to get to specifics and not to labour anything...

- Any meetings with officials/ members... of foreign governments should be made public within 24 hours
- Any donations by political machines of foreign nations should be made public within 24 hours

- Any relations with senior union leaders, foreign governments, foreign corporations or wealthy Australians must be made public immediately. Period.
- Any gifts, including travel, from any person to any MP or senior staff member must be recorded and made public within 24 hours.
- AND we need a strong independent federal UICAC well before the next election to which any and all breeches can be referred with a belief of a solid and transparent investigation.
