

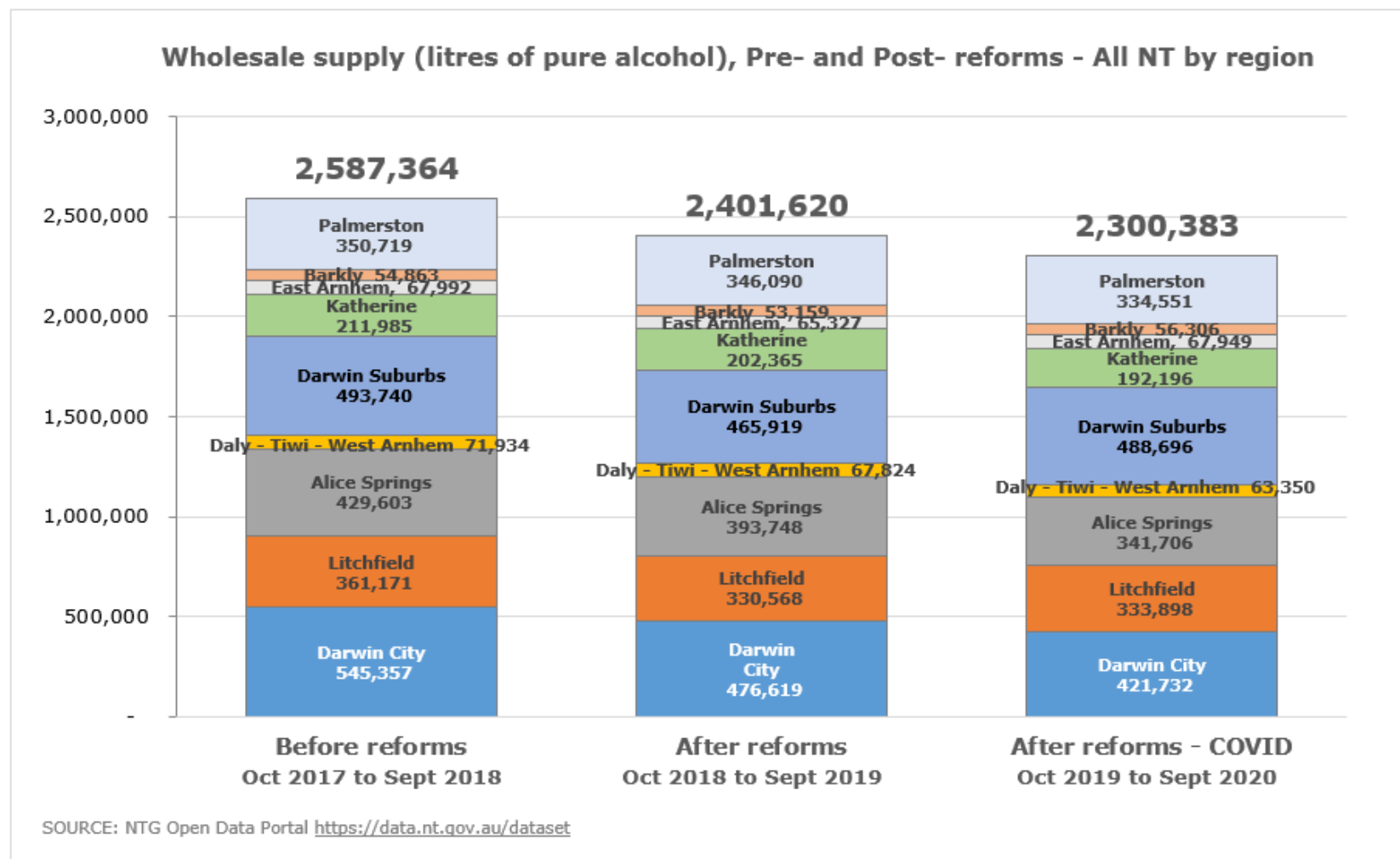

# Wholesale supply of alcohol in the Northern Territory, 2017-2020

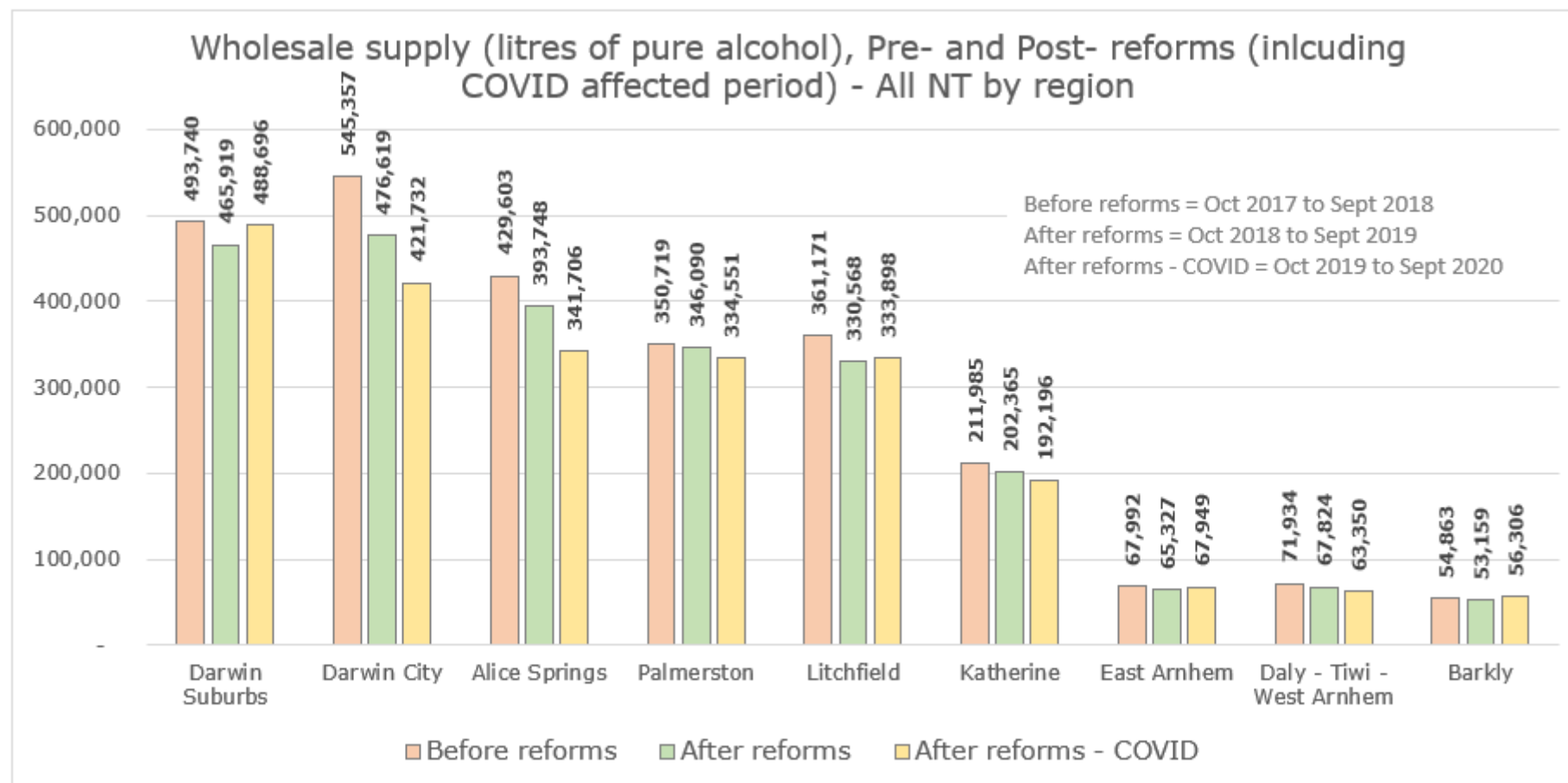

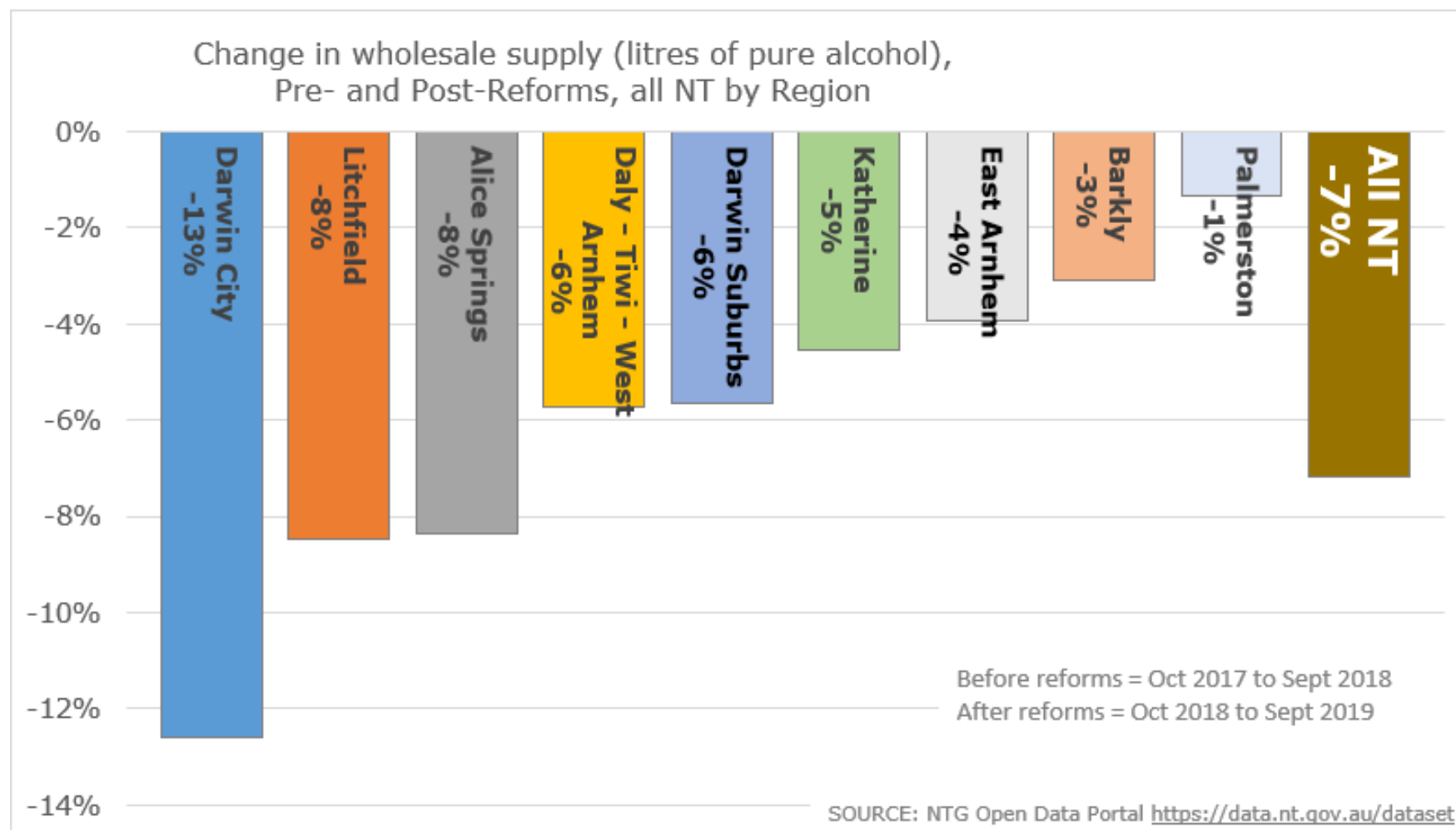

This graph compares the annual wholesale supply of alcohol in the Northern Territory before and after the Alcohol Reforms of October 2018, including the period affected by COVID-19 restrictions following the declaration of a public health emergency in the NT on 19 March 2020. Figures after December 2020 have not yet been released, so full year comparisons after September 2020 are not yet possible.



This graph provides an alternative view of the annual wholesale supply of alcohol in the Northern Territory before and after the Alcohol Reforms of October 2018, including the period affected by COVID-19 restrictions following the declaration of a public health emergency in the NT on 19 March 2020. Figures after December 2020 have not yet been released, so full year comparisons after September 2020 are not yet possible.



This graph shows the effect of the Alcohol Reforms of October 2018, comparing the years immediately before the Reforms with that immediately following them (prior to the effects of COVID-19). Wholesale supply decreased by 7% across the NT.
