Inquiry into the Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-Terrorism Financing and Other Legislation Amendment Bill 2019

We refer to your letter dated 18 February 2020 advising of the receipt of submissions concerning Crown by the Senate Legal and Constitutional Affairs Legislation Committee in relation to the above matter.

These are matters which Crown takes very seriously and are the subject of various state regulatory inquiries including the ILGA Inquiry under section 143 of the *Casino Control Act 1992* (NSW). In these circumstances, it is not appropriate for Crown to further comment, save to say that Crown strives to meet its compliance and governance requirements and has no desire to be used by criminal elements.

We welcome the Committee's review of the Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-Terrorism Financing and Other Legislation Amendment Bill 2019 and await the outcome of that review.
