Parliamentary inquiry into transition from the ADF

The Defence Sub-Committee of the Parliament's <u>Joint Standing Committee on Foreign Affairs</u>, <u>Defence and Trade</u> is holding a public hearing in Brisbane on Monday 27 August for its <u>inquiry into</u> transition from the ADF.

Chair of the Defence Sub-Committee, Senator Linda Reynolds CSC, said the Sub-Committee will hear from individuals and representatives of Ex Service Organisations and Mental Health Researchers on the efficacy of support services available to members of the ADF transitioning out of active service, particularly focussing on mental health care, employment pathways and the role of Ex-Service Organisations (ESOs).

"The inquiry aims to improve the services available to ensure all our veterans have access to mental health care and employment opportunities, including whether there could be a greater role for ESOs in providing ongoing support," Senator Reynolds said.
