This week at a glance

There were 15 disallowable instruments tabled in the Parliament. These were made under eight separate enabling Acts, through four Departments of State.

Statutory Rules

Two of the 15 instruments were Statutory Rules, comprising

- one made as a primary instrument; and
- one made as an amending instrument

Six instruments were made by the Governor-General or Ministers

Nine instruments were made by Public Officials
