RULE 21—Honorary members may, after the first month of honorary membership, be permitted by the committee, if duly proposed, to continue honorary members for a further period of three months—not necessarily consecutive—upon payment of the subscription monthly in advance. An honorary member shall not in any case be eligible as such for any period exceeding four months in any year. For the purposes of this rule, the year shall begin on the date of admission, an honorary membership, during the extended period, for any part of a month shall be deemed honorary membership for a whole month, and the month shall be reckoned from the day on which the subscription is payable.
