CHAIR: How many transfers of licence occur each year?

Mr Day: I'd have to take that on notice.

Question

Mr Day: That's true. The point I'm ultimately getting at is: the number of licences with that

authorisation in the market now is very low.

CHAIR: How many?

Mr Day: I'll take that on notice. As I say, we've handed out very few—it would be a handful—with that authorisation since 2014; we scrutinise those very strongly. As a result, the off-market price of such a licence has been going up considerably over the last eight years.

Answer

As at 13 December 2022, there are 50 Australian Financial Services licences with at least the same authorisations as held by FTX Australia Pty Ltd.* Eight of these 50 were granted licences since 2014:
