Opening of the 46th Parliament

The Deputy of the Governor-General opened the 46th Parliament in the Senate. Following a suspension of sitting, the Governor-General addressed the members of both Houses assembled in the Senate. <u>Watch on ParlView</u>

Senator Scott Ryan was elected as President of the Senate, and Senator Sue Lines as Deputy President and Chair of Committees.

The Leader of the Opposition in the Senate, and the Leaders of the Australian Greens, the Nationals, Pauline Hanson's One Nation, and Centre Alliance advised the Senate of various party appointments.
