I refer to your letter dated 12 February regarding PwC's evidence at the Senate Finance and Public Administration References Committee's (committee) public hearing held on 9 February 2024.

I wanted to correct two statements made during the hearing last Friday that were inadvertently incorrect. First, in relation to the line of questioning about the email titled 'Whistleblower complaint—Luke Sayers', I stated that we had provided the opportunity or suggestion that the individual might like to lodge the email outlining concerns into our ethics system directly to facilitate correspondence on a confidential basis. That opportunity or suggestion was not included in the initial response to the individual, as I had believed. We have now rectified this.

Secondly, Mr Burrowes incorrectly answered a question about his current remuneration. The correct answer is \$2.8m.

Mr Burrowes and I apologise to the Committee for the incorrect statements outlined above.

We will revert to you by 1 March with any other amendments to our evidence.
