PRESIDENT'S REPORT TO THE SENATE ON THE STATUS OF GOVERNMENT RESPONSES TO PARLIAMENTARY COMMITTEE REPORTS as at 30 June 2019

BACKGROUND

Twice a year the President provides a report to the Senate on the status of government responses to Senate and joint committee reports.

Government responses to committee reports are required within three months of a report being tabled, and must be provided to committee chairs as well as tabled in the Senate.

This practice has arisen from a Senate resolution of 14 March 1973, in which the Senate declared its opinion that the government should provide a response to committee reports within three months of tabling.² Successive governments have affirmed their commitment to providing such responses.³

REPORTS THAT REQUIRE A GOVERNMENT RESPONSE

Generally, if a committee report makes a recommendation to government then that report will require a government response.

However, Senate committee reports on bills which contain recommendations that could only be addressed during the consideration of the bill—for example, a recommendation that a bill be passed, rejected or amended—do not require a separate government response and therefore are not included in this report. If such reports contain other recommendations that do require a government response, the response may also be provided during debate on the bill rather than via correspondence to the committee chair and tabling in the Senate.

Reports by committees on estimates or scrutiny of annual reports are not included in this report, unless they contain recommendations that require a government response.

Reports of certain domestic committees, including Appropriations; Staffing and Security; Privileges; Procedure; Publications; and Senators' Interests, are not included in this report unless they contain recommendations that require a government response.

Reports of the Selection of Bills Committee on the referral of bills to committees are responded to via the Senate's adoption of the committee's report, and are therefore not included in this report.

Reports of scrutiny committees on legislation are not generally included in this report because those committees correspond directly with ministers in relation to legislative scrutiny matters. However, any reports of these committees that make recommendations that require a government response are included in this report. The Parliamentary Joint Committee on Human Rights, for example, occasionally undertakes ad hoc inquiries that address policy recommendations to government.

Reports of the Joint Committee of Public Accounts and Audit usually make administrative recommendations to departments and agencies, and responses are provided in the form of either a government response or an executive minute provided to the committee and tabled in the Senate.

Reports of the Joint Parliamentary Standing Committee on Public Works (PWC) are not usually included in this report. Responses to the PWC are normally reflected in the outcome of motions in the House of Representatives for the approval of works recommended in the committee's reports.

GOVERNMENT REPORT ON THE STATUS OF RESPONSES

This report should be read in conjunction with the Government report on the Status of responses to parliamentary committee reports as at 30 September 2018_(the government report), which was tabled in the Senate on 12 November 2018.

The government report routinely provides an interim response to committee reports that 'The Government's response is being considered'. Responses of this type are identified in the 'Date response tabled/presented' column of this report as 'Interim*'.

If a final response was provided during debate on a bill rather than via correspondence, the government report usually states that 'The Government's response was provided during debate on the bill'. Responses of this type are identified in the 'Date response tabled/presented' column of this report as 'Final*'.

ABBREVIATIONS

In this report 'HoR' indicates the date on which a report or response was tabled in the House of Representatives.
