## **Answer:**

No, the ACCC has not previously undertaken statistical analysis of broadband speeds as captured by monitoring hardware.

In 2015, the ACCC completed a pilot broadband performance monitoring and reporting program and published the following report:

The pilot program tested approximately 90 Melbourne-based home fixed-line broadband connections over a three-month period, and focused on the technical and practical elements of introducing a future monitoring and reporting program.
