**11QW:** Music industry: APRA-AMCOS authorisation process

Will the upcoming authorisation process consider introduction of additional conditions that impose clear performance measures regarding transparent reporting obligations?

Answer:

If and when APRA seeks re-authorisation, the ACCC will apply the relevant statutory test. Broadly the ACCC may grant authorisation if the likely public benefit from the conduct outweighs the likely public detriment.

The Competition and Consumer Act (2010) permits the ACCC to specify conditions in an authorisation. Where possible, the ACCC will provide the applicants and interested parties with an opportunity to comment on proposed conditions.
