**Mr CRAIG KELLY:** And what about for loaning to small business?

**Mr Münchenberg:** Again, we can come back very easily with those figures. I do not have them at my fingertips.

**Answer:** There are no data that provide an insight into the ABA members' share of lending to small business.

However, there are data on lending to all businesses as follows.

As at end January 2017, the relevant statistics sourced from the RBA and APRA were:

Business loans outstanding on the books of ABA members	\$604.1 billion
Business loans outstanding on the books of all AFIs	\$875.9 billion
Share of ABA members	69 per cent
