Mr THISTLETHWAITE: Do you agree with Mr Kell, who said, 'The wrong sorts of incentives were in place, absolutely'?

Mr Narev: We've had a look at what was said in the Ernst & Young report and got comfort that there were no incentives that encouraged people to behave in a way which wasn't in the interests of doing business the right way. To the extent ASIC's got a different view, I guess we would disagree with it, but I'll need to come back to you on the specifics of that report.
