Mr CRAIG KELLY: But could I deposit money into someone else's account if I had the account details or can I only put the cash into mine?

Mr Thorburn: I think the answer's yes, but let me take it on notice and confirm.

Answer
Deposits to a NAB account via a NAB intelligent deposit machine can be made without a card, but the depositor needs to enter the BSB and account number or the credit card account number to complete the deposit.
