On 31 March, the Australian Financial Review wrote that a branch manager at a big four bank was reported for berating staff who weren't selling enough of the bank's products, despite customer-facing employees being fearful of losing their jobs or catching the coronavirus.

Effective 1 April 2019, ANZ removed individual financial targets and introduced team financial targets in branches. This change was made to reduce the risk of behaviours or outcomes that are not in our customers' best interests and to focus our staff on greater collaboration.
