How does APRA currently monitor general reserves of superannuation funds? What data do you collect on general reserves? What analysis of general reserves do you conduct? Do superannuation funds have to report these reserves to members anywhere?

Answer:

APRA collects data on operational risk financial requirement, investment, self insurance, administration and other reserves from every RSE, on both a quarterly and annual basis. Through regular supervision monitoring and analysis, exceptions are identified and investigated.

Yes, it must be provided as part of fund information (see CA, s1017DA and CR, r7.9.37).
