Question

Does ASIC consider that penalties should be lower for superannuation funds where there is a risk that a penalty would make the trustee insolvent?

Answer

No. ASIC's approach to enforcement generally is set out in <u>Information Sheet 151</u>.

ASIC, notes that, whilst ASIC provides submissions on the appropriate penalty amount, ultimately, determination of penalty is a matter for the court: *Australian Energy Regulator v Snowy Hydro Limited (No 2)* [2015] FCA 58. In accordance with sections 1311A and 1317G of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth), when a court is considering what penalty to impose, it is required to take into account the impact the imposition of the penalty may have on beneficiaries of the superannuation fund.
