Response to Question 10b

I am not and never have been a citizen of Sri Lanka.

I was born in the United Kingdom in 1972 and became a British citizen at birth. At the time, both of my parents were Sri Lankan citizens and both of them acquired British citizenship after I was born.

However, under Sri Lankan nationality law at the time, I did not become a Sri Lankan citizen at birth because my parents did not register my birth within one year in the prescribed manner at the office of a consular officer of Sri Lanka or the office of the Minister in Sri Lanka. As such, I never became a citizen of Sri Lanka.

Even if my birth had been registered in the prescribed manner and I had become a citizen of Sri Lanka by descent, under Sri Lankan nationality law I would have lost my Sri Lankan citizenship when I turned 22 unless I renounced my British citizenship prior to that date, which I did not do.

I have never taken any steps to apply for Sri Lankan citizenship.

I became an Australian citizen on 26 April 1996 (attached).

On 1 September 2021, my formal renunciation of British citizenship was registered by the British Home Office (attached).




