I became in Australian citizen on 7 September 2010. Under Sri Lankan citizenship law, a Sri Lankan national who obtains a foreign citizenship loses their Sri Lankan citizenship automatically unless they make an application to retain it. I did not make an application to retain my Sri Lankan citizenship when I became an Australian citizen, and I have never taken any steps to reacquire Sri Lankan citizenship. I am solely an Australian citizen.
