

I am directed by the Minister for Justice, Equality and Law Reform to acknowledge that you, Brendan Patrick O'Connor of 1997. Australia born on 2nd March, 1962 in London, England have made a declaration of allenage in the prescribed manner to relinquish your Irish citizenship.
