TO THE HONOURABLE THE SPEAKER AND MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

This petition of certain citizens of Australia draws to the attention of the House:

That Australian Citizens have taken up arms for foreign military and extremist causes including, but not limited to, the *Islamic State* and by doing so they represent a threat to Australia and the safety of Australian citizens.

We therefore ask the House to do all in its power to:

Amend the Australian Citizenship Act 2007 and take any and all action to allow the revocation of the status of Citizen for those who take up arms, provide material support for military/extremist causes or provide financial support for such causes, except where such action is at the direction or authorised by the Government of Australia.
