Indigenous deaths in prison custody by age group and gender

CHAIR: From the data in the Deaths in Custody Report 2017/18, table B1 reports rates of Indigenous Deaths in prison custody by Gender and also separately by Age Group for <u>all</u> Indigenous prisoners.

Noting that there are significant different deaths rates between males and females in custody and also in different age groups for Indigenous Australians in society in general – is there data available for Indigenous Deaths in Custody by both Age Group and Gender?

- 40-54
- +55
