Text says “The Government will provide \$468.3 million over 5 years ...”

The table adds to \$122.6 million.

The difference is \$345.7 million over 4 years for medication medicine for residents of RACFs (in Pillar 3, page 86).

- This was funding provisioned at 2021-22 MYEFO.
- Is now announced for this measure, but does not appear in the table as BP2 tables never include previously provisioned funding, even though the text often will, and does in this case.

Presentation of BP2 is a matter for the Treasury.

The difference in the totals for Aged Care between the \$468.3m (BP2) and the \$522m (SDS / Health documentation.)

The differences are as follows.

Job Trainer (DESE Measure)	\$48.5m (DESE measure not included Health BP2 - we were informed after finalising numbers that this was agreed at \$49.5m)
Continuation of Life checks for 45 to 65 year olds	\$2m
Third Party Quality assessors (difference)	\$3.3m (this measure was recorded in BP2 as \$18.3m – we included \$21.6m in our total due to the inclusion of a \$3.3m Movement of Funds in the lower total)
Difference between health SDS and BP2	<b>\$53.8m</b>
