





## First Action Plan Priorities Fund (FAPPF)

Administered Budget for DSS activities: \$11.922m

Number of DSS activities: 6

Expended: \$2.901m

- The 2022-23 October Budget included funds of up to \$11.922 million (GST exclusive) over four years from 2023-24 to 2026-27 for the First Action Plan Priority Fund (FAPPF).
- This funding was comprised of:
  - up to \$11.416 million for grant activities over 3 years (2023-24 to 2025-26), and
  - up to \$0.506 million in 2026-27 for an independent evaluation of grant activities funded under the FAPPF.
- The purpose of the FAPPF is to fund and support a number of small scale, time limited grants to address emerging priorities in relation to the *First Action Plan 2023-2027* (First Action Plan) under the *National Plan to End Violence against Women and Children 2023-32* (National Plan).
- The department considered 2022-23 and 2023-24 pre-Budget submissions, submissions and consultations as part of the development of the National Plan and First Action Plan, parliamentary inquiry recommendations, commissioned research and evaluations, and work being done across the Commonwealth in relation to FDSV.
- Grant opportunities opened on 24 January 2024, using a targeted competitive approach, and closed on 20 February 2024.
- The organisations that were invited to apply for the grant rounds were selected based on expertise, skills, or previously demonstrated experience and ability to deliver.
- All applications were assessed in line with Community Grant Hub protocols. This included shortlisting applicants based on initial assessment and review of applications by a Selection Advisory Panel.
- Grant agreements with the following successful organisations were executed mid-May 2024 and will cease on 30 June 2026. Activities will commence shortly.
