## Duties

The NDIS is headquartered in Geelong, and has over 100 offices throughout Australia. Given the unprecedented scale and complexity of the roll-out of the Scheme, the NDIA Board is seeking an exceptional leader who has the experience, skills and strong focus on participant outcomes to lead the Agency through the continued roll-out into full Scheme. This is an opportunity to lead a highly committed and experienced team that is delivering a once in a generation change in the way disability supports are funded and provided in Australia.

A commitment and ability to influence contemporary practice through innovation and research to support participant preferences:

Leadership of major transformational reforms or service delivery change programs, involving significant people leadership and stakeholder engagement;

A proven track record of delivering outcomes in a service environment;

End-to-end leadership capabilities, with experience in building high performing teams, backed up by a strong united organizational culture and values, clear accountabilities and performance management;

Superior relationship management in a complex environment, given the participant focused nature of the NDIS, and the importance of working effectively with the disability sector, providers, advocacy groups, and other stakeholder groups, as well

as the Commonwealth and State and Territory governments, including relevant departments; Strong communication, engagement and influencing skills, including refined political judgement, and a commitment to engaging with participants, providers and the broader disability sector;

Strong financial and quantitative skills; and

Resilience, commitment and drive.
