Notes for Tables 1 to 7

Includes, as at 29 September 2023, recipients of the reported income support payments who are determined to be current (including those entitled to be paid or in receipt of zero rate of payment) or suspended from payment on the Centrelink payment system.

Note: From 20 September 2023, the Government has extended eligibility for Parenting Payment Single to single principal carers with a youngest dependent child under 14 years, up from 8 years. As part of the implementation, income support recipients who were single principal carers of a dependent child aged under 14 years were moved to Parenting Payment Single. Around 65,000 income support recipients (the majority of which were JobSeeker Payment recipients) were transitioned to Parenting Payment Single on 20 September 2023, resulting in a significant decrease in the number of recipients of JobSeeker Payment and a corresponding increase in the number of Parenting Payment Single recipients between August and September 2023.

Income Support duration refers to duration on any income support payment, and may not reflect duration on current payment.

*For Age Pension recipients the reported duration refers to duration on current payment type since latest date of commencement, and does not take into account allowable breaks in payment, or previous periods on other income support payments.

From December 2022, Services Australia have implemented a change in the Centrelink payment system to recognise gender other than the sex assigned at birth or during infancy, or as a gender which is not exclusively male or female. To protect the privacy of individuals and comply with confidentialisation policy, persons identifying as 'non-binary' will initially be grouped with 'females' in the period immediately following implementation of this change. The Department of Social Services will monitor the implications of this change and will publish the 'non-binary' gender category as soon as privacy and confidentialisation considerations allow.

Partial Capacity to Work refers to activity tested recipients with an assessed work capacity of under 30 hours per week.

Principal Carer refers to recipients who have principal caring responsibilities for a dependent child under the age of 16.

Indigenous recipients include only those who have voluntarily identified as indigenous. These data may therefore represent an undercount.

To protect individuals' privacy, all cells including any totals and subtotals have been rounded to the nearest 5, values from 1 to 7 are rounded to 5. Zero cells are actual zeros. This may result in non-additivity for some totals. Caution should be taken in re-calculating totals from rounded data, as this may compound the effects of rounding.
