Correction of evidence given at the 2024–25 Supplementary Budget Estimates hearing on 6 November 2024.

We are writing to correct evidence provided to the Community Affairs Legislation Committee during its examination of the National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) on Wednesday 6 November 2024.

We refer to the below extract from page 13 of the proof Hansard which we would like to correct:

Senator STEELE-JOHN: Remind us how much money you were allocated in the reform for progress?

Mr McNaughton: It was \$739 million over four years. Ms McKenzie can confirm.

Ms C McKenzie: It was \$739 million; that's right.

Mr McNaughton: It was \$739 million over four years.

Senator STEELE-JOHN: How much of that \$739 million has been allocated to the eligibility branch?

Mr McNaughton: We'll break that down. There were nine initiatives in there. We will break that down.



We wish to correct the evidence provided and advise that the NDIA was allocated \$732.9 million over 4 years from 2023–24 which included **8** initiatives. Of the **\$732.9 million**, the Scheme Eligibility Branch had expenditure of \$5.9 million in 2023–24, and has a budget allocation of \$16.0 million in 2024-25. In addition, we refer to the below extract from page 15 of the proof Hansard which we would like to correct:

Mr McNaughton: In the last six weeks, we did 7,487 eligibility reassessments. Of them, 32 per cent changed their status; they moved from section 25 to section 24, so 32 per cent stayed on the scheme but moved into permanent disability. A further 48 per cent exited the scheme. They were revoked. We're still seeking more information about the remaining per cent. They are the three sets of decisions.

We wish to correct the evidence provided and advise, over the specified 6-week period, the total number of eligibility reassessments was 7,507.
