Certain utility scale wind towers, whether or not tapered, and sections thereof (whether exported assembled or foundation section.

Wind turbines that have electrical power generation capacities equal to or in excess of 1.00 megawatt (MW) an to the bottom of the nacelle (i.e., where the top of the tower and nacelle are joined) when fully assembled.

A wind tower section consists of, at a minimum, multiple steel plates rolled into cylindrical or conical shapes an coating, end-finish, painting, treatment or method of manufacture, and with or without flanges, doors, or interr junction boxes, electrical cabling, conduit, cable harness for nacelle generator, interior lighting, tool and storag
