Once the job seeker has been found capable of meeting their requirements at a Capability Assessment, they will enter the Penalty Zone.

Job seekers with a Dement Count of 5 in the above table have had a Capability Assessment triggered which had yet to be finalised as at 30 April 2021. Job Seekers with a Penalty Count of 0 were in the Penalty Zone but had not incurred a penalty as at 30 April 2021 - may include those who had a Capability Assessment Finalised, or were recommenced in the Penalty Zone after serving a preclusion period, prior to 30 April 2021.

When a Capability Interview or Capability Assessment is finalised with a result of Not Capable, the Employment Services System will assign a single reason for this result for reporting purposes. This reason is assigned by the System using a hierarchical matrix. While the system will only suggest one reason for the job seeker/participant being found not capable, the capability review may reveal more than one reason for the job seeker/participant being found not capable e.g. there may be errors in the Job/Participation Plan and the job seeker/participant may have disclosed new information.

Geographic cohorts have not been provided as the department is currently updating its methodology for determining geographic classification of job seekers. This information will be provided in future updates.
