Request to correct testimony in Senate Estimates - 27 October 2021

I am writing to correct evidence I gave to the Senate Standing Committee on Education and Employment Legislation on 27 October 2021.

As recorded at Proof Hansard page 91, in response to a question from Senator Pratt regarding the significance of correspondence between the Fair Work Commission's President and Deputy President Dean, I said:
