### CFMEU ADMINISTRATOR

#### REPORT FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR

The Construction, Forestry and Maritime Employees Union's (**CFMEU**) Construction & General Division was placed into administration on August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2024, and is presently overseen by the Administrator.

The purpose of the Administration is to continue the role of the Union in representing members, ensuring members are safe at work, protecting members' wages and conditions, identifying and removing any corrupt individuals from union positions and addressing corruption within the industry, and dealing with menacing behaviour.

Since August 23<sup>rd</sup>, the Administrator has visited and/or scheduled a visit with each state and territory branch to engage with their respective organisers and staff. In addition, the Administrator has had scores of meetings with stakeholders including key employees within the CFMEU, peak union bodies, peak bodies representing employers, some of the largest employers and has held multiple meetings with a variety of regulators and law enforcement bodies.

The Administration has initiated a number of disciplinary processes, some of which have resulted in the termination of employment of some CFMEU employees. The Administrator has launched several investigations into allegations of corruption pursuant to his powers under the FWRO Act, the Determination and cognate powers conferred by Queensland and NSW laws.

Currently, there are six investigations underway at different stages of progress concerning various industry-wide and specific corruption matters.

The Administration has facilitated the approval of Enterprise Bargaining Agreements (EBAs) through the Fair Work Commission and has dealt with concerns raised by the FWC about concerns about how agreements are made.

Additionally, the Administration has successfully recovered more than \$3.5 million in members' funds from third parties.

Underscoring the urgent need for enhanced worker safety in construction, the calendar year 2023 saw 45 construction worker lives tragically lost, which was a 36% increase on 5-year average for this industry (which is 33 p/annum). However, this number represents a fraction of construction workers who die as an indirect result of their work, due to exposure to dusts and other workplace hazards (inc. silica / asbestos / UV / diesel).

The key actions taken by the administration are set out below:
