In relation to Senator the Hon Richard Colbeck and Senator Kerrynne Liddle's question on Questions on Notice to Mr Jamble.

55 questions taken on notice during the hearing in October 2023.

183 questions were received in writing with the last question received on 15 November 2023.

A total number of 238 questions with 94 lodged by 15 December 2023. Of the remaining 144 questions:

- 39 response were provided to the Minister's office in November 2023
- 104 response were provided to the Minister's office in December 2023
- 1 response were provided to the Minister's office January 2024

15 questions had not been provided to the Minister's office by 15 December 2023.

NIAA develops and approves the response and provides it to the Minister's office for Clearance. In line with 4.16.1 of the *Government Guidelines for Official Witnesses before Parliamentary Committees and Related Matters - February 2015*<sup>1</sup>, the NIAA lodges the response with the Committee as soon as the clearance is received.

In relation to a response to Senator Lidia Thorpe's question on Custody Notification Service to Ms Jenkins.

Ms Jenkins stated that the amount announced was \$4.2 million for 2024-25 however it did not include a \$200,000 NIAA Departmental component and therefore the correct figure is \$4.4 million.

In relation to Senator Lidia Thorpe's question on IAS funding to Mr Creagh.

As at 31 December 2023, \$227.14 million (17.2%) of the IAS is committed to non-Indigenous Organisation.

In relation to Senator Jacinta Nampijinpa Price's question on Fraud recoveries since 2022 to Mr Worth.

The NIAA has not received return of any funds lost as the result of fraud prosecutions since 2022. This is because there have been no prosecutions finalised since 2022, and as a result no reparations orders have been issued.
