REPRIORITISATIONS AND SAVINGS

- Key savings and spending reprioritisations in the 2023-24 MYEFO include:
 - \$7.4 billion through changes to the Infrastructure Investment Program following the Independent Strategic Review (2023-24 MYEFO, page 279, Building a Better Future Through Considered Infrastructure Investment).
 - \$285 million for the replacement of Bushmasters gifted by Australia to Ukraine, to be funded from within the existing resourcing of the Department of Defence (2023-24 MYEFO, page 231, Replacement of Bushmasters).
 - \$273 million over 11 years through responsible investment decisions on National Water Grid projects (2023-24 MYEFO, page 224, National Water Grid Fund delivering commitments).
 - \$266 million by better targeting employment services by exiting participants who are fully meeting their mutual obligations (2023-24 MYEFO, page 237, Better Targeting Employment Services).
 - \$112 million from reprioritisations within the Education portfolio (page 234, Education reprioritisation).
 - \$65 million from changes to the eligibility, compliance, and case management for the Farm Household Allowance program to ensure it is better targeted (2023-24 MYEFO, page 215, Farm Household Allowance eligibility changes).
 - \$37 million from the Information, Linkages and Capacity Building Program to progress the National Disability Data Asset (2023-24 MYEFO, page 290, Progressing the National Disability Data Asset additional funding).
 - \$32 million from efficiencies within the Health and Aged Care portfolio (2023-24 MYEFO, page 255, *An Effective and Clinically Appropriate Medicare*).
 - \$16 million from reprioritisations within the Employment and Workplace Relations portfolio (2023-24 MYEFO, page 239, Employment and Workplace Relations reprioritisation).
