


## 1. References—comparison at same point of last 3 Parliaments

## 3. Hearings held-comparison at same point of last 3 Parliaments




# Select committee activity

- Select committee (including joint select committee) activity during the 46<sup>th</sup> Parliament rose to levels not experienced before, requiring the Senate department to at one point support 12 select committees concurrently. Currently in the 47<sup>th</sup> Parliament, there are four Senate select committees and one joint select committee.
- The table below compares the number of Senate select and joint select committees across the last five parliaments.
- From the commencement of the 47<sup>th</sup> Parliament, the Senate department is committed to providing a total of 116 months of secretariat support to select committees, with the longest single commitment being 33 months.


# Senate Select Committee and Joint Committee activity in the $47^{\rm th}$ Parliament

*Staffing:* The current staffing level in the Committee Office is 76 FTE. The following chart shows changes in average staffing levels over time.


## Senate Committee Office

# Administration

The current annual budget for the Committee Office is approximately \$11.1 million. This includes employee expenses of \$10.8 million and administrative expenses of \$0.3 million. So far in the 2023-24 financial year (as at 31 December 2023), the Committee Office actual expenditure is \$5.6 million.
