

The Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet does meet the costs of the Prime Minister's internet connection at Point Piper. The Prime Minister currently has an ADSL connection. The cost of the service is:

ADSL	\$129.95 pm
Line Rental ADSL	\$ 51.94 pm
Phone Line	\$ 51.94 pm plus call costs (minimal)

NBN is not yet connected to Point Piper.

NBN is now available in the street and the Department will arrange the connection as soon as possible.

Point Piper connection will be HFC (Hybrid Fibre Coaxial).

This is an entitlement for all Senators and Members, as set down in the Ministerial and Parliamentary Services Handbook.

For Ministers the cost is met by their home department.

The Lodge also has an ADSL line – NBN is not available.

Kirribilli House operates on ADSL. NBN is now available in the area and we expect to connect in the near future.
