



Standing Committee references in the first 3 months of each Parliament





- The department also supports six joint committees and two joint select committees.


Staffing

Average staffing for 2018–19: The Average Full Time Equivalent staffing level in the Committee Office for 2018-19 was 65.

Administration

The current annual budget for the Committee Office is approximately \$8.9 million. This includes employee expenses of \$8.5 million and administrative expenses (including secretariat travel, accommodation and venues for hearings) of \$0.4 million.

In 2018–19, total operational costs for the Committee Office were \$11.1 million (including corporate overheads).
