On page 73 of the transcript, in response to a question from Senator Pratt, Mr Rogers stated:

**Mr Rogers:** The Operation Dureau that you refer to in one article there, the accused was sentenced to a period of 18 months and a \$1,000 good behaviour bond.

ACLEI wishes to clarify that the accused was actually convicted and sentenced to an 18 month, \$1,000 good behaviour bond.
